Information regarding the Brussels litigation

Following the European Commission's findings against Gascogne SA and Gascogne Sack Deutschland (ex Sachsa Verpackung) imposing a fine on the companies amounting to €13.2m, upheld by a decision from the Court of First Instance of the European Communities in November 2011, the companies had instituted appeal proceedings before the European Court of Justice, against the ruling by the CFI, and in the alternative, the reduction of the amount of the fine.

The European Court of Justice, following the hearing held in February 2013, has now rendered its decision and dismissed the appeal by Gascogne SA and Gascogne Sack Deutschland (ex Sachsa Verpackung) on all counts and has definitively upheld the ruling against the Group.

Payment of the fine amounting to €13.2m, together with accrued interest of €3.6m, (provisioned in the financial statements) becomes due as of today.

A bank guarantee had been obtained for payment of the fine and was invoked by the European Commission.

The Gascogne Group's reimbursement of the amounts paid by the guarantor banks to the European Commission will be included in the discussions underway concerning the whole of the Group's debt. In the meantime, the Gascogne Group has requested a standstill agreement from the banks.
